This year started malignantly for Minnesotans, and we've learned a whole new meaning to the phrase "Ice Out". Like thousands of people across the Twin Cities, many of us on the East Side spent months feeling under siege. Some of us picked up new hobbies for a while; spending time on a corner, talking to neighbors over walkie-talkies, giving rides to strangers (new friends?), making unusual deliveries, tailing suspicious vehicles... Minnesotans can be a resilient and creative people.

For the AitH planning team, we had a lot on our mind when we started planning the festival. At that point, we could only hope the oppression we felt in January would be fully lifted at the beginning of Summer. We like to think of the festival as the kickoff to Summer on the East Side, and we celebrate it here in Swede Hollow Park- the beachhead for waves of immigrants to find a home in St Paul. **COMMUNITY** is one of our building blocks at Art in the Hollow. Our community is our multicultural neighborhood, our diversity of artists, our tapestry of neighbors and partners, and all the welcome guests who visit us on festival day.

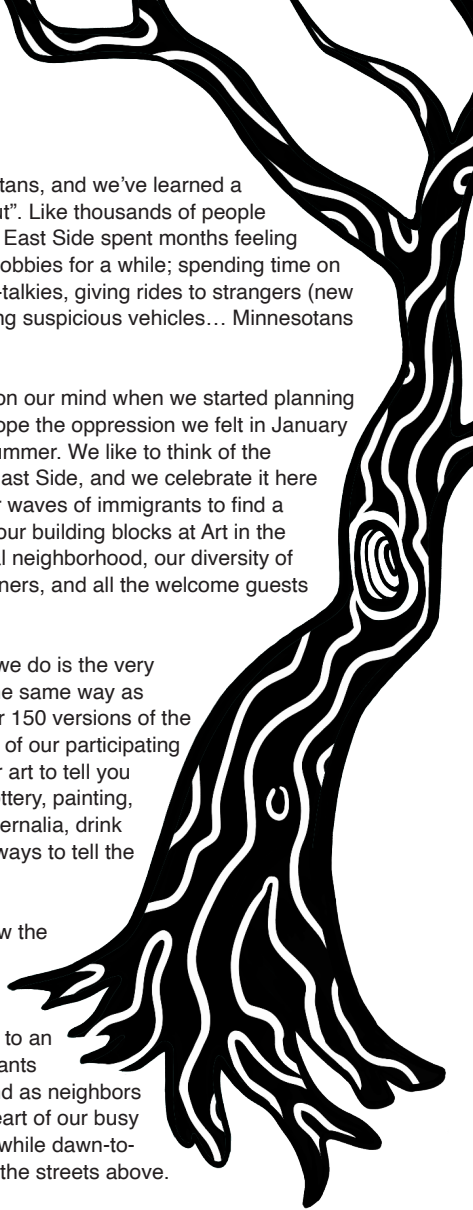
Telling the story of who we are and what we do is the very essence of **ART**. 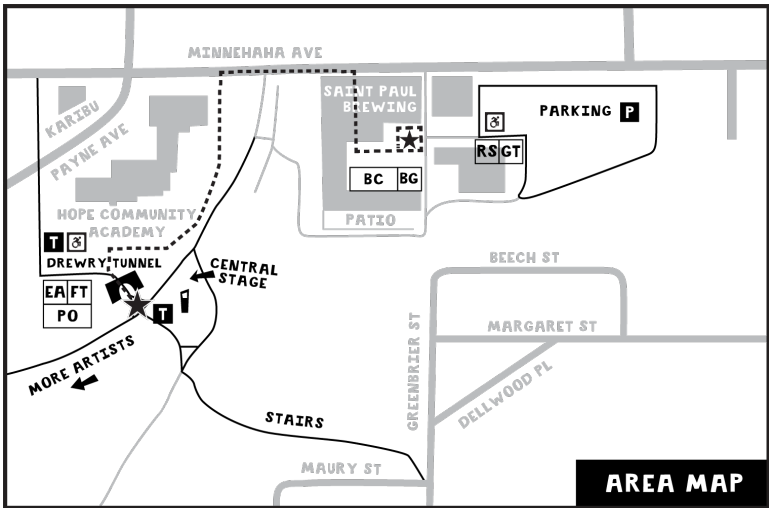

**GETTING FROM PARKING TO THE FESTIVAL:**

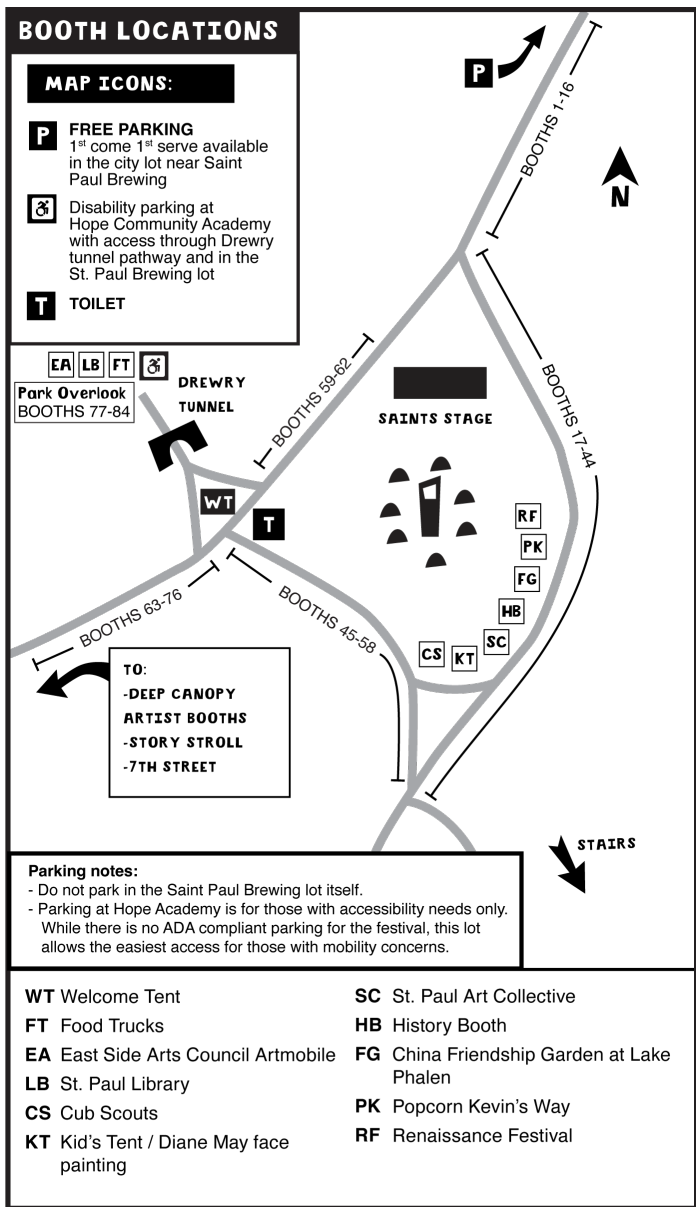

While walking from the main parking area to the festival, enjoy a story stroll brought to you by the St. Paul Public Library!

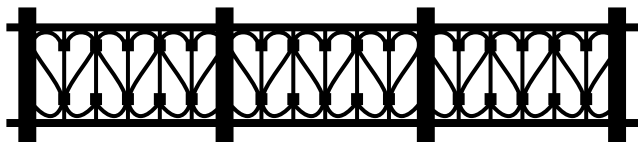
## **BEER GARDEN IN THE BREWERY COURTYARD**
